

BAW2 Marking Points Summary

Examples by size of module and number of assessments

This table details how many minutes staff are allocated to mark assessments depending on whether they teach 15 credit modules or 30 credit modules. This includes reading, comments and feedback, mark collation, plagiarism check and reports (if necessary).

Course Credits	15 cr	15 cr	30 cr	30 cr
Number of Assessments	1 item	2 items	2 items	3 items
BAW2 Marking Points	mins/item	mins/item	mins/item	mins/item
0.015 (Standard)	21	10	21	14
0.0275 (High)	38	19	38	25
0.04 (Highest)	55	28	55	37

So a 15 credit module with two assessments, e.g. a presentation and a 2000 word essay, where on Standard setting for Marking Points would only allow you 10 mins to mark each student presentation and 10 mins to mark each essay.

For 10, 20 or 45 credit modules the calculation principle is the same. For example, a 45 credit module with 1 assessment provides 63 mins for marking each item on Standard setting for Marking Points.
